The Colonial Region is proud to announce the 2012 Williamsburg CARavan -- seven days of memorable touring in historic Virginia. The CARavan will be a hub tour based at the Williamsburg Hospitality House -- only half a mile from the Colonial Williamsburg Historic District. The CARavan is planned at a leisurely pace so you will have ample time to relax and enjoy the many attractions the area has to offer. The CARavan will cover approximately 500 miles on flat rural roads.

Sunday – Registration will be late Sunday afternoon, followed by an evening Welcoming Social at the hotel.

Monday will be spent in the Williamsburg and Yorktown area with visits to the Jamestown Settlement Visitors Center, the Jamestown National Park, the Yorktown Victory Center and Yorktown National Battlefield. Travel to the two sites will be on the lovely Colonial Parkway — the perfect road for Classics!

Tuesday will include a drive west of Williamsburg with stops at Shirley and Berkeley Plantations, two of the finest James River 17th and 18th century mansions. After lunch we will visit the New Kent Winery for a wine tasting. Dinner will be at Shield's Tavern in Colonial Williamsburg followed by the Williamsburg Ghost Tour.

Wednesday will take the CARavan across the James River by ferry to visit historic Smithfield, and two car collections. Lunch will be at the waterfront home of region members Dwight and Jane Schaubach where we will have an opportunity to enjoy some southern hospitality and visit their automobile collection.

Thursday will be an off day to provide an opportunity for an in-depth visit to Colonial Williamsburg. You can easily spend a day visiting the colonial Governor's Palace, the Virginia House of Burgesses, the museum, the numerous colonial houses and shops, and the many skilled craftsmen practicing their 18th century trades in the historic area. Or you may chose to enjoy some of the many other attractions in the Williamsburg area. In the evening we will have a buffet dinner at the Williamsburg Winery.

Friday includes a drive to Petersburg to visit the Petersburg Battlefield (The Crater), the Siege Museum, famous Blandford Church with 12 stunning Tiffany windows, the Civil War Soldiers Museum and the historic district of Petersburg.

Saturday will include a drive to Richmond, Virginia's capital, where we will tour several attractions including the Virginia State Capitol which was designed by Thomas Jefferson and has been the site of many historic events.

Sunday, the final day of the CARavan, will include a visit to nearby Hampton and Newport News where we will tour Fortress Monroe and the world class Mariner's Museum. The Mariner's Museum recently opened a new wing to house artifacts recovered from the USS Monitor. The CARavan will conclude with a closing banquet at the host hotel on Sunday evening.

The **Williamsburg Hospitality House** will be our host hotel at a group rate of \$119 plus taxes. Call the hotel at (757) 229-4020 and ask for the "Classic Car Club of America" rate. Trailer/Truck parking will be on the William & Mary campus at \$90 for 9 days.

REGISTRATION & ACTIVITIES FEE: The CCCA CARavan Registration form is in the May and Nov Bulletins and online. We estimate the Activity Fee will be approximately \$550 per person, which will include lunches on the tour days, four evening socials and entrance fees for all venues except Colonial Williamsburg. Because the Historic District is open to the public, you can see and enjoy much of the district at no cost. However, in order to enjoy the full Colonial Williamsburg experience, we recommend a One Day Pass that includes tours of the Colonial Capitol, the Governor's Mansion, the Raleigh Tavern and much, much more.

- *Shirley and Berkeley Plantations* – Visit two of America's earliest and finest 17th and 18th century homes
- *Car collections and wine tasting*
- *Colonial Williamsburg Historic District* – One full day (no driving planned) to experience Colonial Williamsburg-- America's "Crown Jewel". Or visit some of the other attractions--William & Mary College, antiques stores, two large discount malls
- *Petersburg* – Visit the Siege Museum, the Civil War Soldiers Museum, and Blandford Church with 12 beautiful Tiffany stained glass windows
- *Richmond* – A tour of the historic Virginia State Capitol and more
- *Hampton* – Walk the ramparts of Fortress Monroe (Edgar Allen Poe served here, Robert E. Lee helped construct it, and Jefferson Davis was imprisoned in it) and visit the world class Mariner's Museum's new USS Monitor displays
- *Children are welcome* – this will be an enjoyable and educational CARavan – Busch Gardens is open Fri, Sat and Sun
